## Rolls

## Crafts and Baked Goods

If you bring newly-made (not used) craft items or fresh baked goods to sell, we ask that you price these items at home. It will be of great help to the ladies in charge of those tables. Prices will not be marked down without the permission of the seller. Please have your wares to the church by **8:00 a.m.**

## Salads

Each salad needs to be at least (3) quarts and can be jell-o, potato, pea, macaroni, cauliflower, broccoli, etc. Salads should be brought to the church by **10:00 a.m.**
